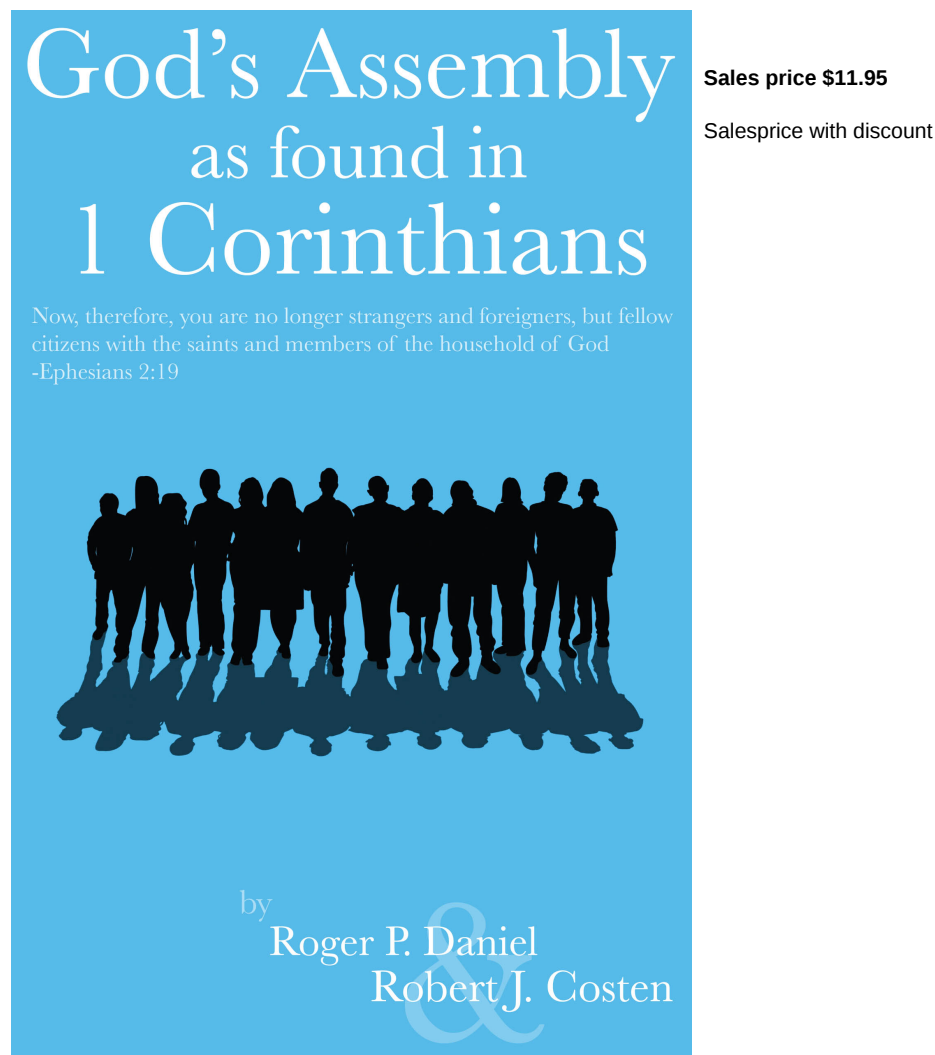




Description

Although Paul wrote earlier epistles, conditions didn't warrant a detailed letter spelling out the truth of the Church, which was Paul's special ministry to believers. But that all changed with the problem-plagued assembly at Corinth. Thus in especially 1 Corinthians we get the basic outline for a functioning local assembly and how to handle problems within an assembly. It is an epistle every believer should be familiar with! It was not until a decade later that actual division took place, and that needed the further instruction of 2 Timothy, but that is the subject of other books. We trust you will profit from this study of 1 Corinthians by our two well-known authors. They have expanded on "Christian giving"-taken up especially in 1 Corinthians 9 and 16-near the end of their book.
